

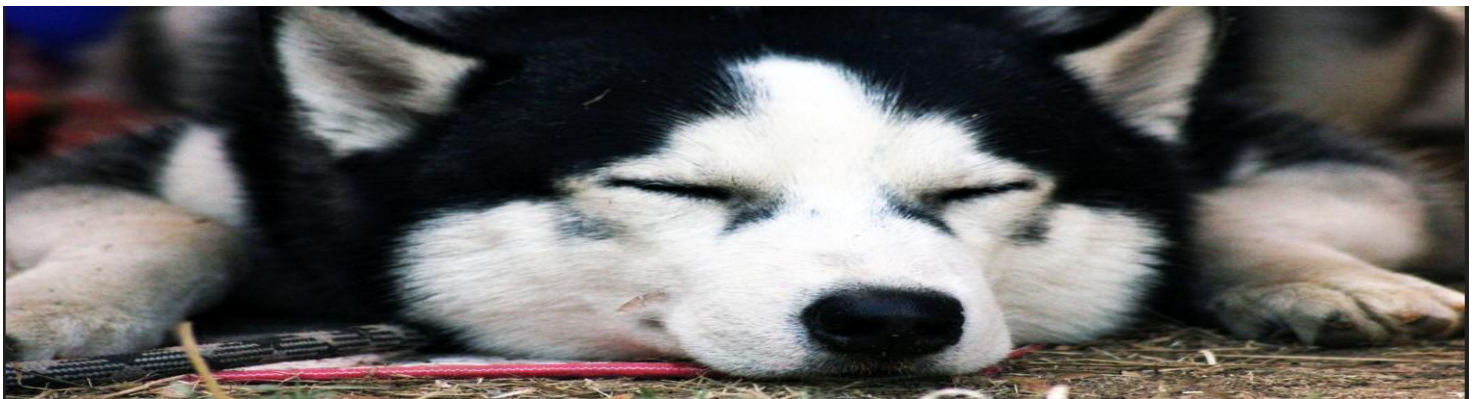


## **BRAIN GAMES for RAINY DAYS**
